Scholarships at William Academy

Wiliam Academy supports efforts to develop and educate future global leaders. William Academy is dedicated to contributing to the community and supporting students to further their education through its scholarships. "Merit-based" scholarship opportunities are available to deserving students who exhibit academic excellence and proven leadership skills.

Scholarships recognize the academic achievement and contributions to the community that students have made. All students, regardless of their country of origin, are eligible to apply for scholarships. Students wishing to apply for scholarships will need to submit a scholarship application form.

Scholarships Available

Students are eligible for all of the following scholarships on an additive basis, provided that they meet the scholarship criteria and requirements. Interested applicants should follow the instructions in the "How to Apply" section further below in this document. Suitable candidates will be contacted for an interview. Applicants must be currently enrolled in Grade 8, 9, 10, 11 or 12 to be eligible.

1) William's General Entrance Scholarships for International Students (\$5,000)

Each year, up to 30 William's General Entrance Scholarships are granted to deserving international students to provide them access to one of the best education systems in the world. William's General Entrance Scholarship is merit-based and considers multiple attributes of a student and their application.

2) William's Principal English Scholarships for International Students

Each year, up to 30 William's Principal English Scholarships are granted to deserving international students with strong English proficiency to provide them access to one of the best education systems in the world. William's Principal English Scholarship is as follows:

- If English proficiency is demonstrated to be IELTS 5.5 (or equivalent): **\$1,000 scholarship**
- If English proficiency is demonstrated to be IELTS 6 (or equivalent): **\$1,500 scholarship**
- If English proficiency is demonstrated to be IELTS 6.5 (or equivalent): C\$2,000 scholarship

3) William's Principal Academic Scholarships for International Students

Each year, up to 30 William's Principal Academic Scholarships are granted to deserving international students with strong academic performance to provide them access to one of the best education systems in the world. William's Principal Academic Scholarship is as follows.

- For applicants who have a combined GPA over 80%, **\$1,000 scholarship**
- For applicants who have a combined GPA over 85%, **\$2,000 scholarship**
- For applicants who have a combined GPA over 90%, \$3,000 scholarship

4) William's General Entrance Scholarships for Domestic Students

Each year, up to 5 William's General Entrance Scholarships are granted to deserving students with Permanent residence or Canadian citizenship and covers the full amount of tuition for awarded students. William's General Entrance Scholarship is merit-based and considers multiple attributes of a student and their application.

Scholarship Renewals and Scholar's Responsibilities

Scholarships are renewable for up to three years provided the student:

- 1. Maintains a GPA of 80% and above in all courses that they take with William Academy, and
- 2. Are determined to contribute positively to the school community.

How to Apply

Students wishing to be considered for scholarships must provide the following:

- 1. School transcripts from the most recent two years,
- 2. For international students, IELTS Test Report (Academic if applicable) or other official English proficiency test result,
- Student's resume. The resume should include any volunteer experience, any awards received, activities that the student participates in and considers most significant, and any additional personal information that may be beneficial to share with the Selection Committee, and
- 4. Maximum 500-word essay to the following question: *If you could choose any person in the world you would like to be, who would you choose and explain why.*

All documents must be emailed to <u>admissions@williamacademy.ca</u> together with a complete William Academy Application Form before deadlines listed below.

Scholarship Application Deadlines:

- September Intakes April 3rd of every year
- November Intakes July 3rd of every year
- January Intakes **October 3**rd of every year
- March Intakes **December 3**rd of every year
